The Ontario Senior Open 5 Pin Championships shall be bowled at Sherwood Centre in Hamilton, Ontario during the period March 28-31, 2018.

Zone Champions competing in the 2018 Ontario Senior Open 5 Pin Championships will receive:

1. Awards
2. Free Bowling at Provincials
3. Victory Dance

Each team will bowl five (5) players and count five (5) scores in a match play format.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. O5PBA Green Book rules will govern this tournament.
2. This Championship is open to all members of the Ontario 5 Pin Bowlers' Association, **50 years of age and over** as of **December 31 of the current bowling season**, residing in Ontario.
3. Entry Fee is to be decided by each Zone Association.
4. All participating Zones (minimum of six (6)) must pay the designated assessment for this event.
5. **All bowlers, coaches and assistant coaches participating in the Provincial Championships must pay an additional assessment fee to be determined.**
6. All bowlers wishing to qualify for both the regular open and seniors open must declare, prior to the start of the tournament, their intent and pay the prevailing entry fee, prior to throwing the first ball.
7. Entry Deadline and Qualifying dates - See entry panel. Acceptance of late entries are subject to availability of lanes.
8. Entry form, along with a cheque or money order must be sent and made payable to the organization listed in the entry panel.
9. Zone Associations will conduct their own roll-offs. Ten (10) games will be bowled. **To qualify for the Open, a bowler must bowl one (1) game to be eligible.**
10. The top three (3) men and the top three (3) ladies based on total pinfall at the completion of the Zone Finals shall qualify for the Provincial Championships from **March 28-31, 2018**.
11. In the event of a tie for the last qualifying position, a one (1) game roll-off shall be held to determine the final placing.
12. Any bowler who entered both the regular and seniors open, and has qualified for both, must bowl in the regular open and forfeit their spot on the Seniors team.
13. All qualifiers who withdraw after having qualified to advance to the next level of competition are subject to automatic suspension from future participation in the Ontario Open Championships until that suspension is successfully appealed.
14. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to complete the field, and all decisions by the committee will be final.
15. **All bowlers must hold a membership card in the Zone in which they participate. All entries are subject to membership verification.**
16. a) All bowlers may bowl in the Zone of their "Principal Residence".
Definition: As a guide, Principal Residence shall be the residence individuals use for taxation purposes, driver's licence, etc. Bowlers with more than one residence, such as commuters or individuals living away from home for employment reasons, must contact the Provincial Office for a ruling.
b) All qualifiers to the Zone Contingent shall have their residence verified by the Zone Association Tournament Director.
c) The penalty for bowling in the wrong Zone is an automatic suspension from the event.
d) All decisions may be appealed. Requests to have suspensions lifted must be made in writing to the Provincial Board of Directors. (For exceptions to this rule, see Green Book, Zone Finals, or contact your Zone Tournament Director).
17. Bowlers/coaches who compete in regular league play as registered members of an O5PBA sanctioned or affiliated league in a Zone other than their principal residence, and have played the year prior in that other Zone, will be allowed to compete in the Open in that other Zone by filing a "Declaration of Intent" to the Zone Tournament Director by **October 31, 2017**. A copy of the current year (2016-17) average sheet confirming their current participation in said league or in another league, within that same Association, must accompany the "Declaration of Intent". **Furthermore, I understand that it is my responsibility to ensure that this form is submitted to the Ontario 5 Pin Bowlers' Association by the deadline date established. Please Note: In the prior season a bowler/coach must have bowled a minimum of fifty (50) games in a sanctioned or affiliated league of the Zone they wish to declare in, and be listed on the o5pba.ca website average book for that league to be eligible to declare. Once a Declaration of Intent is filed the bowler/coach cannot bowl/coach in the Zone of their principal residence for that year. If a declaration form is not filed by that date, the bowler/coach must compete in the Zone of their principal residence. Note: A coach who is not actively bowling at all (not an O5 member from any league) can coach in a non-resident Zone.**

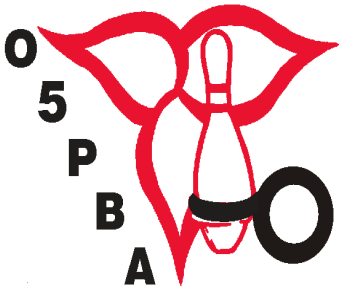
